#### What is GROW?

GROW (G21 Region Opportunities for Work) is an ambitious initiative which aims to address entrenched place-based disadvantage.

GROW focuses on job creation (using social procurement and investment) and ensures jobs also flow to the most disadvantaged communities in the G21 Region.

Together we can make sure that the benefits of living in this region are shared - that the quality of life that it offers are available to all, and that our region's growth is inclusive.

GROW will initially focus on three target areas in the G21 Region where unemployment can be between two to three times higher than regional averages: Norlane-Corio, Whittington and Colac.



## What is the GROW Compact?

An agreement between GROW and organisations in the G21 Region, in which the organisation aims to:

- buy local to support local businesses, organisations and suppliers to improve economic and social outcomes
- > work with social enterprises, not-for-profit businesses and organisations who help support vulnerable communities
- > strengthen employment and training opportunities for targeted job seekers
- > collaborate with other GROW partners to address disadvantage and support economic participation in our region
- reflect this commitment in their policy and practice

#### **GROW PURPOSE**

...to create opportunities for work across the G21 Region particularly in and around areas of entrenched place-based disadvantage



By moving just **7%** of the G21 expenditure from non-local to **local** suppliers, together we can generate:

- > 2,500 jobs (500 for GROW targeted communities)
- > \$1 billion into the regional economy
